Greg Boyce is the former Chairman and Chief Executive Officer of Peabody Energy and was named one of America's Most Valuable CEOs by *Chief Executive* magazine, ranking 36th among S&P 500 chief executives. Greg trained as a mining engineer and had a four decade career in the mining and energy industry. He is a 2014 inductee into the American Mining Hall of Fame.

Boyce holds a Bachelor of Science degree in mining engineering from the University of Arizona and an Advanced Management Program degree from Harvard University's Graduate School of Business. He is a member of the Board of Directors of Marathon Oil Corporation, Monsanto Company, and Newmont Mining Company. Greg is also on the boards of Washington University of Saint Louis and the Heard Museum in Phoenix, Arizona.
